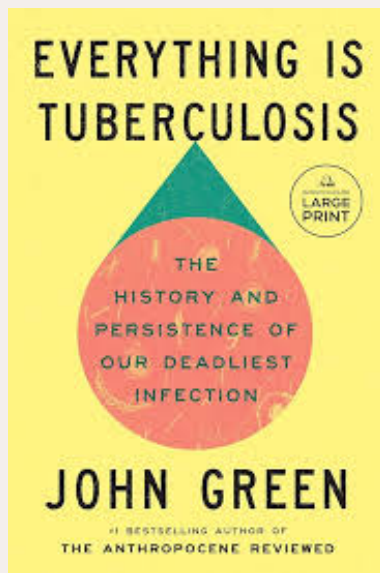

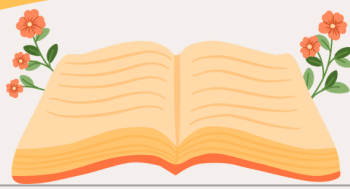
### Storytime: Thursdays at 10:30
