Hello Westford community,

For those I haven't had the chance to meet yet, my name is Maggie Kabbeko, and I'm the new Director of the Westford Public Library. While I wish my first introduction to many of you were under easier circumstances, I'm grateful for the warmth, patience, and support our community has shown during this temporary closure.

I'd like to share a clear update on the building, our expected reopening timeline, and the services and programs available while remediation is underway.

Library Building Update

The library remains temporarily closed while building remediation is completed. This work is important for the long-term safety and health of the space, and it is actively moving forward.

Our current projection is to reopen the library by mid-January.
