All families interested in homeschooling are invited! This space is intended to help homeschooling families connect.

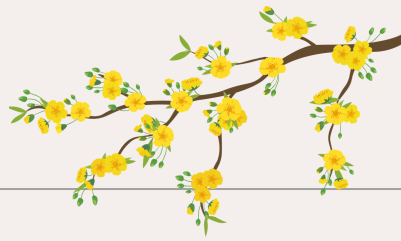


Knitting with Neighbors + Board Games
